

Guidelines for "PROF. D. N. TRIKHA EXCELLENCE IN RESEARCH PUBLICATION AWARD"

This award is started on the basis of a donation received from PEC Alumnus, Prof D.N.Trikha who graduated in the year 1959 from Department of Civil Engineering. The award will be given from the interest accrued on the donation received, which will be invested in fixed deposit. The award is for PEC Faculty and will be presented annually to two faculty members for excellence in research paper publication in refereed International Journals that have resulted from the research done at PEC.

Name of the Award	:	"PROF. D. N. TRIKHA EXCELLENCE IN RESEARCH PUBLICATION AWARD"
Objective	:	To recognize faculty members of PEC for excellence in research publication through the papers published in refereed international journals that have resulted from the research done at PEC.
Frequency of the Award	:	Annual
Number of awards per year	:	Two
Award	:	7500/- each + Certificate
Committee for selecting Awardee(s)	:	Committee will consist of 5 members a. Director – As Chairperson b. Deputy Director (Member) c. Dean Academic Affairs (Member) d. Dean Alumni Affairs/ (Dean Research Planning and Development) (Convener) e. Donor or his Nominee (Observer)
Guidelines for the Award	:	1. Applications for the award will be invited once a year from faculty members of PEC (regular as well as those on contracts) at the beginning of each calendar year.


2. The award will be given for the research paper(s) published during previous calendar year in refereed international journals that have resulted from the research done at PEC.
3. If applicant has completed his/her PhD work outside PEC the applicant will become eligible to apply for this award only for research papers published in calendar years which are at least two years after the year in which his/her viva voce was held (eg. if viva voce was held in the year 2009, the applicant will be eligible for the papers published in the calendar year 2011 onwards.)
4. The following points will be considered by the award committee.
 - (a) Quality/ status of journal/ paper
 - (b) Number of authors/ coauthors of the paper (lower number is better)
 - (c) Paper based on the research work with outside financial support
 - (d) Social benefits, (if any) of the publication(s).
 - (e) Recognition/ award for the paper by Publisher/ Society.
 - (f) Any other point considered important by the Award Committee.
5. (a) If sufficient applications, with high quality of papers are not received, then an award may not be given in a particular year and can be carried forward to the next year(s).
- (b) If deserving candidate(s) cannot be awarded due to large number of applicants, their case can be recommended by the committee for consideration next year. i.e carried forward by only one year.


(c) Coauthors of the paper shall be awarded jointly and the prize money shall be shared between amongst coauthors. If Coauthor(s) is a research scholar /student he/she shall be given certificate(s) only.

(d) An award will usually not be shared between more than one awardee (with different publications) except in very rare and exceptional circumstances.

(e) The number of awards per year can increase or decrease depending on the surplus/deficit availability of funds.

Life of the Award	:	20 years
Maintenance of Accounts	:	Accounts will be maintained by PEC
Surplus/ Deficit	:	Any surplus or deficit will be intimated to the donor on annual basis.
