II. Qualifications:

For Sr. No. 1 to 2

Essential:

- i) First class (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii) Ph.D. degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. degree) Regulations, 2009.

For Sr. No. 3

For Humanities:- Psychology

Essential:

- i) Master's degree with minimum 55% marks in Psychology followed by Ph.D or equivalent in the relevant area.

Note: In case of non-availability of suitable Ph.D. candidate, the candidate with Masters Qualification may be considered.

For Sr. No. 4 to 8

Essential:

1. First class in both Master's Degree and Bachelor Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering (Engg.) & Technology (Tech.).
2. Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:
 - i) Teaching, research, industrial and/ or professional experience in a reputed organization.
 - ii) Papers presented at conferences and/or in refereed journals.
 - iii) Candidates with PhD would be considered for higher emoluments.

III. Emoluments:

- i) Pay for candidates with M.E. / M.Tech. and Ph.D. in Applied Science & Centre for Management & Humanities will be Rs.48,000/ (Consolidated)
- ii) Pay for candidates with Ph.D. in Engineering will be Rs.52,000/- (Consolidated)
- iii) Higher pay may be offered to exceptionally qualified candidates at discretion of Selection committee & approval of Director, PEC.

IV. Other terms & conditions.

1. **Age:** 37 years.
2. The candidate should be a citizen of India. Candidates from transgender may also apply.
3. Existing norms of the Government of India for age relaxation and other relaxation (if any) in reservation will be followed.
4. The posts for visually disabled and hearing disabled persons shall be filled as the Government of India norms.
5. Reservation policy of the Government of India will be followed. The OBC non-creamy layer certificate issued by the competent authority which should not be older than six months from the date of publication of advertisement will be accepted as proof in support of claim as OBC candidate.
6. SC certificate, on the prescribed form only, issued by the competent authority declared by the Government of India will be accepted as proof in support of claim as SC candidate.
7. Visually disabled / Hearing disabled candidates shall produce medical certificate issued by competent authority in support of their claim.
8. The candidates may report for walk-in interview along with original documents and one-self attested copy of documents in the Board Room, adjacent to the Director's office, Punjab Engineering College (Deemed to be University), Chandigarh as per above schedule. List of documents to prove: Identity preferably Adhar card, Passport size photograph, Age, Caste Category certificate (SC/PwD/OBC), Educational Qualification, Experience, Research Papers etc.
